<u>Coronavirus – updated government guidance issued</u>

The government has issued new guidance for all UK citizens who are returning to the UK from specific areas affected by COVID-19: specific lockdown areas in northern Italy, special care zones in South Korea as designated by the government of the Republic of South Koreas and the Hubei province.

If you have recently returned from any of these areas you are advised to self-isolate at home for 14 days and call 111 for NHS advice and guidance, even if you are not displaying any symptoms of the virus.

If you travelled to any of these affected areas during half term please advise the school asap.
