Stranger Danger



It is our responsibility to help our children make better decisions about their personal safety. Children see strangers every day in stores, in the park, and in their neighbourhoods. Most of these strangers are nice, normal people, but a few may not be. Parents can protect their children from dangerous strangers by teaching them about strangers and suspicious behaviour, and by taking a few precautions of their own. Please make your child aware of the Top Tips in keeping safe around strangers.
