
Mrs Muraro will be at the gate every afternoon if you ever wanted to speak to her. She would love to get to know you all more so we can support your child as best we can.

Healthy snacks and drinks

- Fresh drinking water is available all day, so please send your child in with a named water bottle that they can refill – water fountains have been turned off as part of Covid-19 control measures.
- A snack of fresh fruit or veg *only* is allowed at break – all other snacks will be removed and handed back to the child at the end of the day.
- Sweets and chewing gum are not permitted in school.



PE

PE for both classes will be on a Friday and Tuesday.

Children will need to wear the following to school:

- black shorts and plain white t-shirt.
- trainers / plimsolls
- black jogging bottoms and a plain black hoodie as the weather gets colder. If you don't have plain black hoodie please wear their school jumper.



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Home Learning: sent home Friday

- Will all be issued online via Class Dojo.
- Children will be trained in this in school.
- Spellings will be sent home with a spelling task.
- Words need to be learnt for a test on the following Thursday.
- Spelling task linked to their spelling pattern being learnt.
- There will also be an alternating English and Maths task.
- Children should read for 20 mins a day. This needs to be recorded in their reading record books. Please encourage your children to complete any quizzes for books read. Children will bring home books daily and these can be changed as regularly as needed.
- Accelerated Reader quizzes may be taken at home or at school.
- Daily practise of times tables – Timestable Rockstars can be used for this.
