Driving question: How are people different and the same?

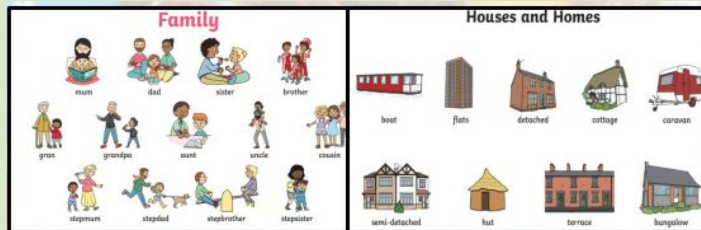
HOME LEARNING

Ten things you need to know about the Me, Myself & I

1. I can talk about how I have changed since I was a baby
2. Recall and order key events from my life
3. Know when my birthday is
4. Discuss how you are the same and different from members of your family
5. Name different celebrations in your family
6. Name immediate family
7. Identify who came before me in my family and who came after
8. Understand that families are all different
9. Recognise that you are an individual and unique
10. Know that families change over time

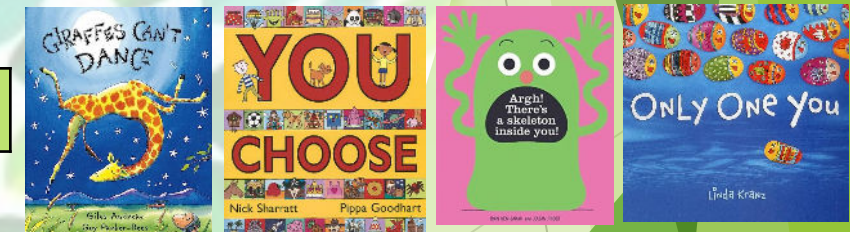
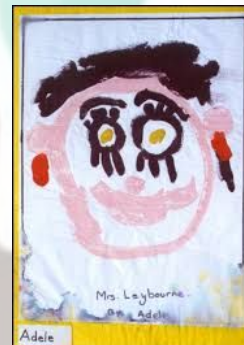

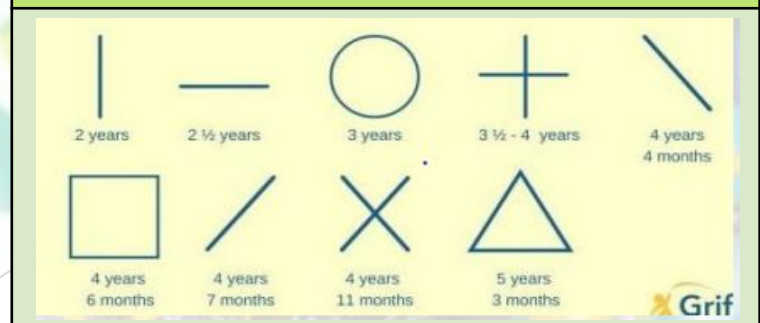
