STICKY KNOWLEDGE FOR SCIENCE

1. A habitat is a place where living things, such as animals and plants, can find all of the things they need to survive. This includes food, water, air, space to move and grow and some shelter.
2. Some habitats are large, like the ocean, and some are very small, such as under a log.
3. Some habitats in our local area include the river and woodlands. Other habitats include the coast and the forest.
4. Ocean habitats are a very large expanse of sea.
5. Woodland habitats are land covered with trees.
6. Polar habitats are within the North or South Pole.
7. Microhabitats are very small habitats where minibeasts may live.
8. Examples of microhabitats include under stones, in grass, under fallen leaves and in the soil.
9. Minibeasts that can be found there include worms, snails, ants, centipedes, millipedes, and butterflies and they help to keep the microhabitat healthy.
10. Minibeasts are able to survive in their habitats because they can find the things they need to survive there, such as food and water. For example, caterpillars can survive on leaves as they give them food.

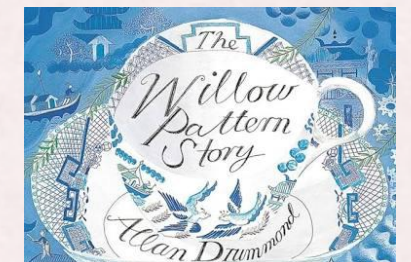
